A special meeting of the Plainfield Charter Township Board and Planning Commission was held on May 25, 2010 at 7:00 PM in the Township Board Room located in the Township Offices located at 6161 Belmont NE, Belmont, Michigan 49306. Members in attendance: Supervisor Meek, Clerk Harvey, Treasurer Stover, Trustees Hagedorn, Matthews and Weldon. Trustee Borek was not in attendance. Also in attendance were members of the Planning Commission Marie Kessler, David Ridout, Ray Holland, Charles Jylha, Gary Gerber and George Pawlowski. William Fischer the Plainfield Charter Township Community Development Department was also present.

1. Supervisor Meek called the meeting to order at 7 PM and informed all in attendance that this is an informational meeting only and no board action would be taken during the meeting.
2. Mr. William Fischer stated that that he requested that this meeting take place to provide information to the public and the elected officials in neighboring communities about a proposed Sports Complex on 10 Mile Road and there has been no formal request to have any rezoning of the property under consideration for this endeavor. He introduced Mr. Mike Guswieler from the West Michigan Sports Authority who presented an overview of a proposed sports complex that if built would be located on Ten Mile Road in Plainfield Charter Township east of the former Kent County landfill. SCheryl Scales from Progressive A&E shared that she is working on a more detailed project plan and taking into consideration of the topography of this piece of property. Several elected officials from Algoma Township and the City of Rockford asked questions **and** expressed support of the project. Mr. Fischer made it clear that a formal rezoning process would take place in the event the Sports Authority decides to move forward with this project at this location. This process will include an opportunity for the 10 Mile Corridor Planning Committee to review the application and provide a recommendation to Plainfield Charter Township.
3. Supervisor Meek opened the floor to Citizens' Comment's. There were no comments.
4. Supervisor Meek adjourned the meeting at 7:54 PM.
