LICENSING ORDINANCE #97-2

TRASH HAULERS

Section 1. DEFINITIONS. The following terms are defined or clarified as:

- a. "Trash Hauler" shall mean any firm, business, or individual that, for a fee, picks up trash, garbage, and/or recycled products.
- b. "Plainfield Charter Township" is hereinafter referred to as "Plainfield"
- c. "Alpine Township" is hereinafter referred to as "Alpine"

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION OF PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP. Under Agreement #96-20: A Public Act 425 Agreement between Plainfield and Alpine, Section 2.5: Coordination of Efforts, subsection (f), states that Plainfield will license all trash haulers' vehicles serving Alpine Township. Alpine will pay to Plainfield the cost of enforcement hereof, including court costs and attorney fees, that may be incurred with licensing of trash haulers.

Section 3. LICENSE REQUIRED. No trash hauler shall operate within Alpine Township without first obtaining a license through Plainfield as outlined in Sections 4 and 5 of this Ordinance. Licenses shall be issued on or after April 1st of each calendar year.

Section 4. LICENSE APPLICATION. Application for licenses under this Ordinance shall be provided by and filed with the Clerk of Plainfield upon forms provided for that purpose, and shall contain the following information:

- a. The name, address, and telephone number of applicant.
- b. The name, address, and telephone number of business
- c. The type and model of each vehicle used by the trash hauler or anyone contracted to collect trash, garbage, and/or recycled products on his behalf.
- d. The serial number and license number of each vehicle.

Section 5. FEES. The fee for a trash hauler permit shall be on a per vehicle, per year charge as approved by Plainfield and shall not exceed the charges levied for trash haulers in Plainfield. These fees may be changed by resolution as needed to meet the costs incurred by Plainfield for the administration and enforcement of this ordinance. All fees collected for the licensing of trash haulers shall remain with Plainfield in lieu of any fees or charges for this to Alpine.

Section 6. CERTIFICATION. Prior to the issuance of a new license, the Clerk of Plainfield shall conduct an exterior inspection of each vehicle. The trash compartment of all vehicles must be covered or enclosed.

Section 7. TERM and EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective seven (7) days following publication of its provisions in the Grand Rapids Press, a local newspaper of general circulation in Alpine unless an elector files intent to request a referendum within seven (7) days. The Ordinance shall remain in effect through the term of the Public Act 425 Agreement, or until such time that either party gives the other ninety (90) days written notice of the intent to terminate the provisions of this Ordinance.
